
# Sports Turf Canada's Robert W. Sheard Scholarship



Established in 1993, Sports Turf Canada's Robert W. Sheard Scholarship is in recognition of Dr. Sheard's immeasurable contribution and support provided to STC over two decades.

Bob's involvement with the fledgling organization began in 1990 upon his retirement as a Professor of Soil Science at the University of Guelph. He became STC's first Executive Secretary and has played a role in most, if not all, association



initiatives since that time. He was editor and a major contributor to the *Sports Turf Newsletter*, now the *Sports Turf Manager*. He edited and produced *An Athletic Field Managers' Guide* and the *Athletic Field Construction Manual*, and penned the *Constructing the Sports Field* brochure and the text *Understanding Turf Management*, transferring ownership and donating all proceeds to the association. He has served on the boards of the International Turfgrass Society, the Guelph Turfgrass Institute and the Ontario Turfgrass Symposium, among others.

Sports Turf Canada™ (STC) is the professional association dedicated to the promotion of better, safer sports turf through innovation, education and professional programs. In order to further this goal and to encourage, support and provide leadership to those considering a career in the sports turf industry, STC established a scholarship program in 1993 and has since awarded 31 scholarships. The STC Robert W. Sheard Scholarship (\$1,000) may be awarded annually. The scholarship program is funded through STC membership fees. The award is intended to assist students with the cost of tuition, books and related expenses.

#### We encourage you to apply for the STC Robert W. Sheard Scholarship if you:

- Are a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant.
- Are currently enrolled in and have completed two semesters of education in a postsecondary program in turf management at a recognized college or university in Canada; or, have completed the University of Guelph's Turf Managers' Short Course, or equivalent, in the current year.
- · Have a desire to pursue a career in the sports turf industry.

### **Scholarship Policies.**

- 1. Scholarships are non-renewable.
- 2. Candidates will be judged on the basis of the information contained in their Scholarship Application Form and support material.
- 3. Applications must be received by May 30th for consideration.
- 4. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 5. Presentation to the scholarship recipient will be made at an appropriate industry conference or event.
