You will be part of the Sport Services team, supporting over 45 sport field irrigation systems as well as irrigation in the horticultural beds and turf in parks, on medians and boulevards and for our street tree program. You will have considerable practical experience and committed to the delivery of a high level of customer service to the community. Experience in developing water management plans and measuring water consumption of irrigation systems to meet targets would be an asset.

The ideal candidate will have a completion of the tenth school grade supplemented by technical courses in irrigation systems maintenance plus considerable related experience. You must possess an A.W.W.A. Cross Connection Control Certificate and a valid Class 5 BC Driver's License. Applicants under consideration will be required to consent to a Police Information Check/Vulnerable Sector Check.

The City is offering a salary of \$35.08 per hour, an excellent benefits package and compressed work week.
